I can't see. I can't hear.	안보여요. / 안들려요.
May I go to the bathroom?	화장실에 다녀와도 될까요?
May I drink some water?	물 좀 마시고 와도 될까요?
May I borrow a ~? (a pencil / an eraser)	~ 좀 빌려주세요.
How do you spell ~?	~의 스펠링이 뭐예요?
Is this correct?	이것이 맞나요?
Could you help me please?	도와 줄 수 있니?
Could you repeat that please?	한 번 더 말씀해주세요.

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These are the most common expressions that we immediately thought of while preparing these materials. These are the phrases which are most commonly avoided, and coincidentally the most forgotten or cast aside by the students. At first they will probably be overly enthusiastic about using them, but eventually they will attempt to discard these phrases and resort to shouting simple words. Don't let them! - The effect of using these phrases is two fold. It will provide them with practice speaking complete phrases, and give them confidence through positive reinforcement each time they successfully (within reason) use them.

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These are meant to be printed out and cut into slips. Hand the slips out to your students and have them glue them into the inside of their books or somewhere convenient. This way they can refer to them when they would like to try and communicate with you.
